# Penn Township Supervisor Meeting October 2, 2018

Vice-Chairman Brenda Moyer called the 10.2.2018 Supervisor Meeting to order, 7:00 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

On motion by William Moyer, second by Brenda Moyer and board acclamation, to approve the September 19, 2018 supervisor's meeting minutes.

#### Persons Present to be Heard:

<u>Denyel Decker</u> - Ms. Decker distributed a map of Meadowview Estates and indicated where she was requesting a 3-way stop at the intersection of Quarry Road and Meadowview Drive. Ms. Moyer stated that research will need to be conducted before a decision can be made. The Roadmaster and Township Manager will investigate and report back to the Board of Supervisors at the October 17, 2018 meeting. Ms. Moyer suggested that a petition from residents in the area in favor of the proposed 3-way stop would be helpful.

Rodney Ries, Penn Valley Airport - On motion by Brenda Moyer, second by William Moyer and board acclamation, to give Penn Valley Airport a \$1,100 donation as in the past and add to the 2019 budget.

<u>Marvin Weaver</u> - On motion by William Moyer, second by Brenda Moyer and board acclamation, to approve the Final Land Development plan, Developer's Agreement and Stormwater Agreement for Marvin Weaver's Broiler House.

<u>Chris Bailey, Susquehanna University</u> - Mr. Bailey recommended a slight change in the landscape buffer north of the solar array panels located on Susquehanna University's Solar PV Facility. He would like to run the buffer on the NE side of the property. Mr. Bathgate stated that the Conditional Use written decision indicated that they only needed to provide screening for the neighbors but nothing specific on how to do that. On motion by Brenda Moyer, second by William Moyer and board acclamation to allow Susquehanna University to move forward with the screening along the solar panels as depicted in the picture provided. Mr. Housley, neighbor to facility, is present and also in agreement with the change.
