The meeting was called to order by Chairman Brian Wentzel at 6:28 pm.

On motion by Marvin Weaver and seconded by Ken Herman Jr., and carried on a 5-0 vote, the minutes of the June 26, 2023 Planning Commission meeting were approved as presented.

New Business:

Zoning Ordinance Revisions to Allow Poultry in Designated Areas – Discussion was held regarding allowing poultry in designated zones without having to go through a conditional use hearing. Currently, farmettes are allowed by conditional use in the AC, RR and R-1 zones and require two acre lots for Group 1 which is adult average weight of fifteen pounds and is found in Section 1116 (Farmette or Gentleman's Farm).

After discussion, the following changes were proposed: 1) No conditional use hearing required for farmette Group 1 in the AC, RR and R-1 zones; 2) Two-acre minimum lot be lowered to one acre for Group 1 Farmettes; 3) Set-back to remain at twenty feet; 4) The permitted use of Farmette would be subject to Section 1116.

Proposed changes will be formatted into the Zoning Ordinance and be presented at the next workshop meeting.

Old Business:

<u>Bright Farms</u> – Jim Bathgate noted that representatives from Bright Farms attended the June 21st Board of Supervisor's meeting and attended the July 6th PTMA meeting to discuss future plans of process wastewater and sewage. Revised Final Land Development plans are being drafted and PTMA will be taking the lead in other permitting and oversight. The DEP NPDES permit will cover any future tank issues and spills.
