## ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - O

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 96-1, PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS IN THE HARRIS DEVELOPMENT

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by Penn Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Township Ordinance No. 96-1 is hereby amended by adding the following new subsection to Article III, Section 2 (a):
