# ORDINANCE NO. 2007 - <u>07</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF PENN TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 96-1, PARKING AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, PROHIBITING PARKING WITHIN FIFTEEN FEET OF DRIVE ENTRANCES, ESTABLISHING FINES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Penn Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** Article III, Section 3, of Township Ordinance No. 96-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### "Article III

# Traffic Regulations

Section 3. Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations.

(a) Parking is prohibited within the public right-of-way along the following streets or portions of streets:

Street Side Between

- 1. Woodlynn Drive (T-512) North Intersection with 18th Street and intersection with Calvett Place
  - (b) Parking is prohibited within 15 feet of a public or private driveway entrance.
- (c) Any person who violates any provision of this article shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$50.00 and costs.

**SECTION TWO:** The remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 96-1, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

### SECTION THREE: Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective five days after adoption.
