## TOWNSHIP OF PENN SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-<u>03</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENN, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE SPEED LIMIT FOR MOTOR VEHICLES TRAVELING ON CLIFFORD ROAD, TOWNSHIP ROAD # 440, BETWEEN SALEM ROAD AND ROUTE 522, TO 25 MPH FROM ITS EXISTING SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MPH.

WHEREAS, Clifford Road, Township Road # 440, is currently subject to a 35 mph speed limit; and

WHEREAS, the Penn Township Board of Supervisors, in order to advance the welfare and safety of the residents of the Township and such other persons who use said streets and roads, deems it necessary to reduce the speed limit on Clifford Road, Township # 440, between Salem Road and Route 522 to 25 mph;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, after completing appropriate traffic studies on said road, find the following speed limit to be warranted in accordance with the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Penn, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- 1. The maximum speed limit for motor vehicles traveling in both directions along Clifford Road, Township Road # 522, between Salem Road and Route 522, is hereby established at the rate of 25 mph.
- 2. The maximum speed limit for all other areas of travel along Clifford Road, Township Road # 522, shall remain at the rate of 35 mph.

3. This Ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and penalties.
